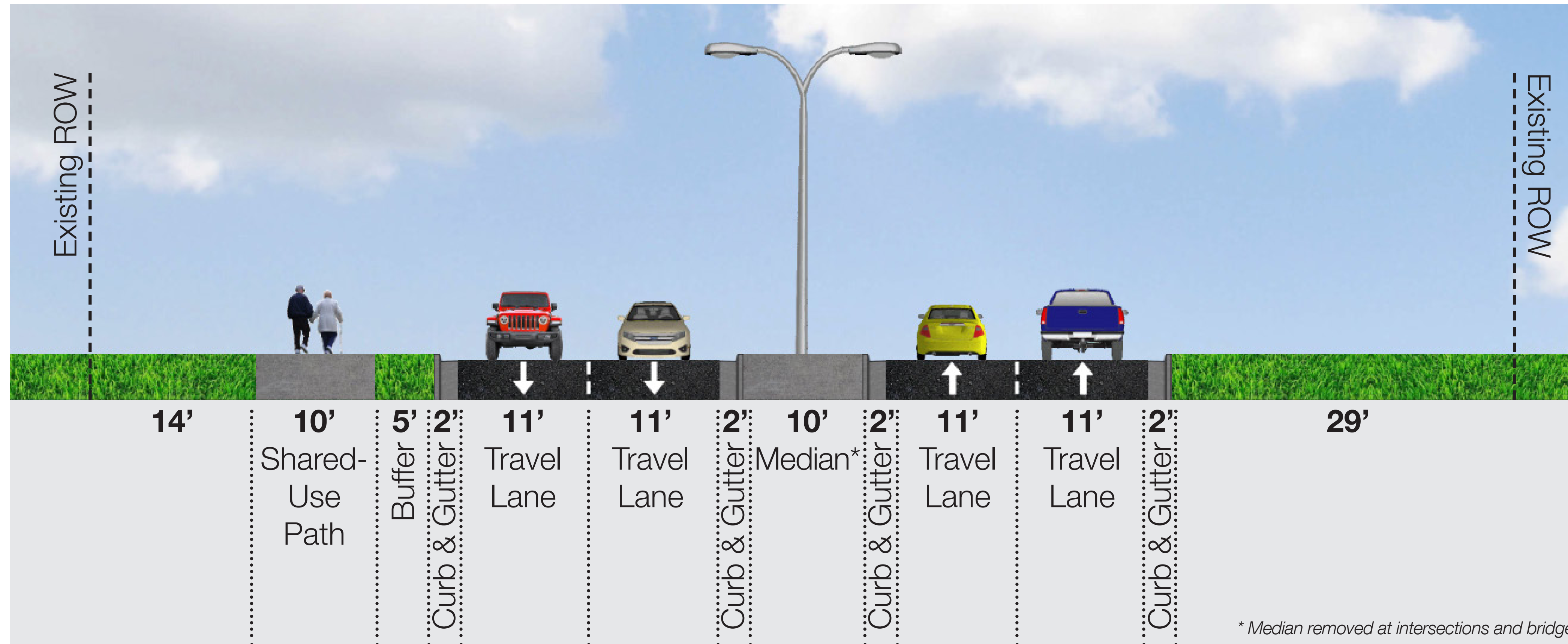

Project Need

The 1.75 mile project will upgrade the existing two-lane undivided roadway to a four-lane divided roadway with left and right turn lanes as needed and a combination of storm sewer and open-ditch drainage. The project also includes a shared-use path for pedestrians and bicycles on one side along with widening the existing bridge that crosses over the San Gabriel River.

Project Need

Williamson County has experienced significant growth in recent years, and current population projections predict that this trend will continue. The City of Georgetown is ranked as one of the top 10 fastest-growing cities by the U.S. Census Bureau*.
