Project Description

The SE Inner Loop project is part of the City of Georgetown - Mobility Bond 2021 that addresses current and future growth to maintain a high level of safety, mobility, and quality of life for residents and communities.

The project will upgrade the existing two-lane undivided roadway to a fivelane undivided arterial roadway from FM 1460 to Southwestern Blvd and to a four-lane median divided roadway from Southwestern Blvd to SH 29 (University Blvd) including a grade separation at Sam Houston Ave and left and right turn lanes incorporated as needed. Drainage will be accomplished with a combination of storm sewer and open ditch. The project also proposes a shared-use path for pedestrians and bicycles on one side and sidewalk on the other. The project design began in 2023 and accomplished with a combination of

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
Project Need

Williamson County and the City of Georgetown have experienced significant growth in recent years, and current population projections predict that this trend will continue. The City of Georgetown is ranked as one of the top 10 fastest-growing cities by the U.S. Census Bureau and has experienced a population growth of 67.94% in the last 10 years^{*}.

Since 2015, Georgetown has been included in the list of the top 10 fastest-growing cities and topped the list in 2016 and 2022. For the second year in a row, Georgetown is the fastest-growing city in the U.S. for cities with a population above 50,000, according to data released [May 18, 2023] by the U.S. Census Bureau. Georgetown's growth rate was 14.4 percent from July 1, 2021, through July 1, 2022, resulting in a population estimate of 86,507*.

The SE Inner Loop widening and reconstruction project will help meet the needs of motorists in one of the fastest-growing areas of the county.
